- I. Streams and drainageways ... R233XY152AK High-elevation Scrub Gravelly Drainageways
- II. All other landforms
 - A. Wetland soils. These include soils that pond, have a water table at very shallow to shallow depths for long durations of time (0 to 20 inches), and/or are classified as very poorly to poorly drained.
 - 1 Depressions often with ≥ 40 cm of saturated organic material
 - 2 Not as above
 - i. Turf hummocks are common landform features. Under the surface peat layer, there is deep, frozen silts. ... R233XY115AK Alpine sedge silty frozen slopes
 - ii. Circles and stripes are common landform features. Under the surface peat layer, there is silty, gravelly, frozen soils. ... R233XY134AK Alpine Dwarf Scrub Gravelly Frozen Slopes
 - B. Not as above, non-wetland soils.
 - 1 Dry and gravelly soils without permafrost. ... R233XY101AK Alpine Dwarf Scrub Gravelly Slopes
 - 2 Moist soils without permafrost. Commonly associated with swales. ... R233XY148AK Subalpine Scrub Gravelly Moist Slopes
